



Conference Tracks

This year we are separating the Breakout Sessions into 3 distinctive track. They include Case Management, Security/Operations and Management. These tracks are designed to focus on those areas of the software that are most important to you or your staff's job function.

Conference Tracks -Day 1

- Case Management/Scheduling will focus on how to instill best practice in the use of the Case Management module in your operation. We will demonstrate how to integrate various forms into your database along with many new instruments including the TCU and OARS. We will explore how our new Clinical Module integrates into various treatment programs you may have or plan to have implemented. Of course, this track will be run in a very open format that will allow you to ask questions and to get answers.
- Security/Operation will focus on how to best incorporate the Security Module into your day-to-day operation. Strong emphasis will be placed on the new Medication Module as well as Quick Log Out, Tasks and how to use Day Reporting. Finally, we will review the powerful Reports area in Security in order to emphasize the best use of these reports. There are a number of very important data elements that are available through these reports that we will explore and discuss. Of course, this track will be run in a very open format that will allow you to ask questions and to get answers.
- Management will focus on how to use the management module in SecurManage™ to measure utility and productivity. We will review and discuss the new QCP/Outcomes Feature (Quality Control Program) that will enable management to monitor and evaluate important data or lack thereof. There will be discussion on how to use SecurManage™ to measure outcomes. We will explore the use of Facility Task and Logs as well as review the upcoming ACA Module. Of course, this track will be run in a very open format that will allow you to ask questions and to get answers.

Conference Tracks -Day 2

- Case Management/Scheduling will focus on how to best use of the Scheduling module in your operation. We will discuss the use of the Day Reporting Scheduling piece in order to best handle any outpatient treatment programs as well as discuss how to schedule conflicts and the upcoming changes that will be made to the scheduling module in the 4th quarter of 2011.
- Security/Operation will focus on how to best incorporate SecurScan and how its use has been expanded to handle new operational issues.
- Management will focus on how to utilize the reports area and how to measure productivity. We will discuss how to use this module to judge how efficiently and effectively staff is conducting day-to-day operations as well as demonstrate the tools at hand to audit operations from the desktop. This session will also include a review of the Accounts module.
